Today we acknowledge the passing of two significant members of our club community, alongside a special recognition by the league, with our highest mark of respect, all grades wearing a black armband – a “Full Club Black Armband” and 1-minute silence.

Reg Davis

8/2/1932-11/1/2024

Reg was a key figure in the early years of the club. As our first Sub-Junior Colts coach (then U/11), he coached that grade for five years from 1968-1972, winning a premiership in 1969, three runners-up (1968 against the other Christies Beach team, 1970 and 1971), with the lowest finish 3rd in 1972. Reg has a special achievement of holding official positions in the 1960s, 1970s, 1980s, 1990s and 2000s. A significant contributor as an administrator, Reg served two stints as President (1973-74 & 1984-87) for a total of six years, was a member of the Senior Committee for at least a further six years (with his last in 2000), and was at various times a member of many sub-committees including the Colts Committee, Building Fund Committee, Club History Project Committee, JLS Bice Oval Committee, Promotions Committee, and Coach Selection Panels.

In 1982 he became the 7th person to be recognised with Life Membership, and from 1990 into the 2000s, he had the unofficial title of Life Member 1, effectively our #1 Ticket Holder.

Reg's association with the club has spanned sixty years, and even as he became less mobile over the past 10-15 years, he would still proudly attend the club when he was able, and could always be relied on to help form a quorum at AGMs. In 2016, in honour of Reg's service to the club, in particular to Junior Football, the Junior Club Person of the Year Award was named the "Reg Davis Award". Reg embraced this honour in his own unique way, attending the presentation night each year whilst he was physically able to present the award, and add his own special touch by giving an additional gift of a biography of a footballer who he admired, and that he thought could be an inspiration to that year's award winner.

A very passionate supporter, he genuinely loved his club, and has been a giant of our club across its existence.

Brian March

Brian joined the club in 1970, playing a total of 61 games, including 11 A-Grade games and was a member of the 1972

B-Grade Premiership. In 1974 he became Secretary for three years, also holding the Football Chairman role in 1975, and served as delegate to the SFL for six years.

In 1976 he left CBFC to join the Southern Football League where he held a number of roles including Chairman of the Southern Junior Football League (2 years), Treasurer, Secretary, President (5 years), Commissioner (12 years) and Patron (14 years).

In 2007, Brian was an inaugural inductee into the Southern Football League Hall of Fame for his service across his time at both the Christies Beach Football Club and the Southern Football League.



Chris Leahy

1/1/1939-2/2/2023

In addition we join the entire Southern Football League community today, with the round dedicated to acknowledging the wonderful contribution by the late

Chris Leahy. Amongst many roles, Chris is the longest serving President of the League and for his extensive service was the first inductee into the Southern Football League Hall of Fame in 2007.



Today's Opponents - Noarlunga

The Noarlunga Football Club first competed in the Alexandra Football Association in 1913 for two seasons, making the Grand Final both seasons, winning it on the second attempt. In 1915 it transferred to the Southern Football Association but lasted only one season due to the competition halting due to the First World War. The competition returned in 1919, with Noarlunga achieving premiership success in 1921-22 and 1925-26. During a period of difficulty, Noarlunga had a short-lived merger with Morphett Vale to form Northern United in 1938 before reforming the following season, and then folding shortly after.



The Noarlunga Football Club was reborn in 1951, returning to the Southern Football Association where they have remained to this day as the current longest continuous members of the league. During that time, they have won a further six A-Grade premierships.
